Nitrous Oxide and Oxygen Sedation Informed Consent

Diagnosis or Problem: Fear and/or Anxiety

Nature and Purpose of Proposed Treatment: To provide sedation and mild analgesia. Nitrous oxide and oxygen sedation provides relaxation, light-headedness or floating feeling, tingling of the hands and feet, warmth, euphoria

Contraindications: Nasopharyngeal Obstruction, severe COPD/Bronchitis, closed tissue spaces (ie. Middle ear disease – Blocked Eustachian tube, Pneumothorax, Bowel obstruction, etc), Bleomycin chemotherapy, claustrophobia, vitreoretinal surgery within 3 months (for detached retina)

Risks/Adverse Events: Dysphoria, Nausea, Dreaming, oversedation

Benefits: reduction of fear and/or anxiety, ability to tolerate dental treatment

Treatment Alternatives: no sedation, oral sedation (oral medication), Intravenous sedation (IV sedation), General anesthesia
